Seth A. Rudnick, MD, is a co-founder and Chairman of the Board of Altesa. Most recently, Seth has also served as Chairman of the Board at G1 Therapeutics and Liquidia Technologies. Previously, he served as a board member for more than two dozen privately and publicly held life sciences companies, including Aralez Pharmaceuticals, Artizan Pharmaceuticals and Meryx Pharmaceuticals. During this period, he has also been and advisor to Pitango and Correlation venture partnerships.

From 1999 to December 2013, Dr. Rudnick was a general partner at Canaan Partners, a venture capital firm that invests in companies in the technology and healthcare sectors. From 1986 to 1991, he was head of research and development at Johnson & Johnson's biotechnology company, Ortho Biotech; and from 1982 to 1986, Dr. Rudnick was head of pharmaceutical development at Biogen N.V. Dr. Rudnick completed his internship and residency in internal medicine at Barnes Hospital in St Louis and his fellowship in Medical Oncology at Yale Hospital in New Haven, Ct. While at Yale he was also a Robert Wood Johnson Scholar. Dr. Rudnick received a B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and an MD from the University of Virginia.
